A class is made up of 3 or more riders. When a class cannot be formed the "move up" procedure outlined in "Building Motos".

Class Combinations: In cases where one or more classes are combined due to low attendance, points are given to each rider according to how they would place in their regular class. Award of the day, will be given by the outcome of the day.

For Example: 2 intermediate riders are grouped together with 3 expert riders. The points will be given as first and second in their class and the award of the day will be given by their actual finish of the day.

New in 2010 for classes with more than 8 riders, lane choice will be awarded in all quarters, semis and mains, based on your moto finishes.

When there is a tie situation in regards to lane choice the tie will be decided by:

- 1. Number of firsts in the motos*
- 2. Head to head results between the tied riders*
- 3. If #1 or #2 still do not decide the tie a run-off moto will be required*

Championship Payouts

Elite pay-out is purse plus 100% payback

Junior pay-out is purse plus 100% payback

Elite Cruiser pay-out is purse plus 100% payback

Junior Cruiser 100% payback

Masters 100% payback

All money classes are paid out at the pre-registration rate.

- Min \$500/ Day Added, Track can add more if they wish

Teams:

- \$100/ event. (requires a min of 3 teams.) Pay-outs are top 3 only (50%, 30%, 20%).
- Team points are the same as expert points, same qualifications as riders Top 5 + Finals.

Year-End

Qualification:

- Top 5 Races + Finals count towards year-end number plates and overall awards.
- Must race 5 Races + Finals to be eligible to earn number plates and awards
- One Out of Province requirement for year-end standings & overall Awards.
- Year end awards by Age and Class

Plates - Distribute 1-8 per **Age & Class**

Awards - Class winners. (7 novice)

Teams – Plaque to winners

Elite - \$1500 to top 3 20'' (1st 50%, 2nd 30% 3rd 20%) (min.3 riders Qualified)
